This weekend will draw a diverse range of perspectives from engineers, data scientists, environmentalists, entrepreneurs, business, finance, science, and more. Together, in teams of 4-6, 150 participants will ideate, prototype, and present solutions in a dynamic, enlightening, and energizing environment in one unforgettable weekend.

The event culminates on Sunday with a demonstration of teams' solutions to panels of judges, with prizes awarded up to \$10,000 for winning team(s). There is no cost to participate. All meals, data, workshops, keynotes, mentors, and space to work is provided.

The World Economic Forum's Transformation maps are a constantly refreshed repository of knowledge about global issues, from climate change to the future of work. They help users to explore and make sense of the complex and interlinked forces that are transforming economies, industries, and global issues.

The maps allow users to visualize and understand more than 306 topics and the connections and inter-dependencies between them. Because the Maps are interlinked, they provide a single place for users to understand each topic from multiple perspectives.
